TRAINING PHILOSOPHY

Practitioners, development organisations, the private sector, public administrations or science institutions require expertise as well as suitable strategies and instruments, in order to take effective steps at all levels (international, national, regional, local) and in all dimensions (social, economic, political-institutional, and environmental).

SLE TRAINING offers a combination of thematic and method-based training courses targeting the interface between science and practice. Since 2005, our renowned short-term training courses in Berlin provide high quality application-oriented and experience-based training, introduce practical methods and tools, support approaches and reflections within the processes of cooperation.

SLE TRAINING courses promote learning through experience: 'Learning by doing' is the most important aspect of our training philosophy. Case studies, teamwork, presentations, discussions and role plays create a learning environment in which participants bring in their own experience and link it to new topics and approaches.
